At Nu-Wall we often hear the question “where does it come from?”; the assumption being that the product is manufactured overseas and is imported into New Zealand. When we respond by saying that the aluminium is extruded in Taranaki and Hamilton, with finishes being applied to order in Auckland, people tend to be pleasantly surprised. Nu-Wall was developed by New Zealanders for our market around 20 years ago, since then it has been specified on all types of projects; both residential and commercial.

While fundamentally adhering to the original design, the Nu-Wall system has in recent years been developed and enhanced to meet the requirements imposed by changes to the New Zealand Building Code. The culmination of this work has seen the publication by BRANZ of three Appraisals covering all applicable installation methods for the product. Detail Specifications relating to these Appraisals are now being made available to Specifiers in an all-new Technical Manual, in a choice of either hardcopy or CD media. These specifications are also available for downloading from the Nu-Wall website in a range of CAD-compatible formats. Additionally, this month’s update to Masterspec will incorporate the addition of Nu-Wall branded sections (Standard and Basic).
