# **Key Features**

- For residential and commercial use
- A counter-balanced, double hung system where both panels move together
- A good option for non-projecting ventilation
- In fully open position with both sashes adjoining each other half the window area is open

## **Design Considerations**

- A good option where non-projecting windows are required
- Consider the ease of reaching to the window catch if the sliding panel is placed beyond a bench
- Opening gap at sill may need to be restricted in high window situations
- Double hung windows will generally be appropriate in single banks because of the large width of coupling bars
- Work well with insect screens.
