Surface Preparation	 NEW & FRESHLY SANDED TIMBER Wash with Cabot's Deck Clean to remove dirt, mildew, mould, oil, wax and tannins. Allow to dry, then coat immediately. Heavy deposits of oil or wax should be removed first with mineral turpentine. 	
	PREVIOUSLY OILED, STAINED OR WEATHERED TIMBER If badly weathered, sand back to fresh timber before coating. If previously coated with a water-based decking oil, simply wash with Cabot's Deck Clean before recoating. If previously coated with a conventional decking oil, first ensure that it has lost its water repellency, then wash as above before coating. If previously coated with a decking stain, wash with Cabot's Deck Clean, sand lightly, remove sanding dust and apply Cabot's Aquadeck.	
Application Procedure And Equipment	 Brush or pad applicator. Stir thoroughly with a broad paddle before and during use. Apply two liberal coats using a quality brush or pad applicator. Apply along the length of the board, including exposed edges and end grain. After several minutes, remove excess with brush or pad applicator.
