<b>Application Procedure And Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Add one part Cabot's Deck Wash in to a plastic bucket prior to adding ten parts of water. Mix well to ensure foam is created.</li> <li>2. Apply generously to the timber with a broom. Scrub vigorously.</li> <li>3. Leave the solution on the timber for up to 10 minutes. Do not allow solution to dry out on timber.</li> <li>4. Rinse off the surface with water using a garden hose to ensure all solution has been washed off.</li> </ul> Heavily soiled or very dirty timber may require repeat application. NOTE: Do not use this product within 2 weeks of coating deck.
