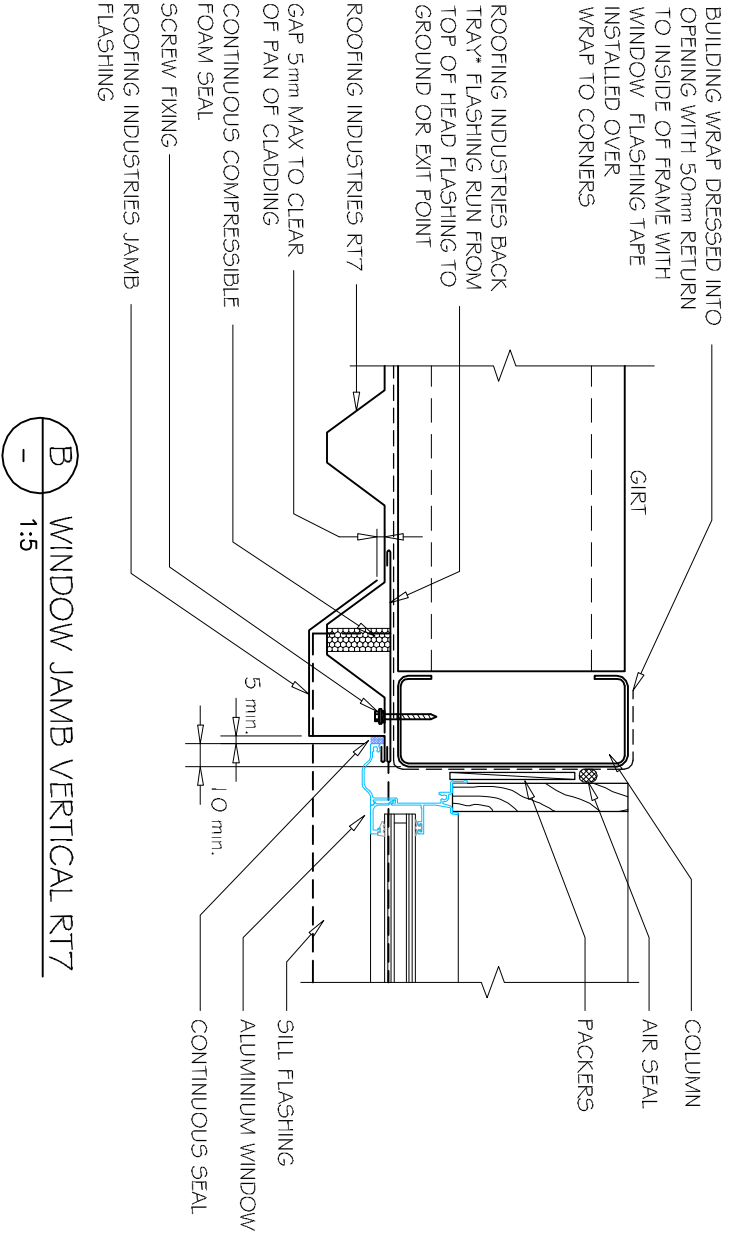


# COMMERCIAL WINDOW / DOOR JAMB FLASHING FOR RT7 VERTICAL CLADDING. (Recessed Window/Door)

## NOTES:

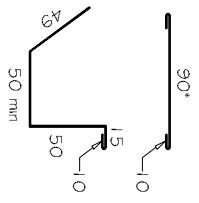
- These details are generally in compliance with the NZ Metal Roof & Wall Cladding Code of Practice and in some cases specific details by Roofing Industries.

- Details of the supporting structure are indicative only and are the responsibility of the building designer.
- Thermal break or cavity battens may be required in some circumstances.
- Underlayment selection and building wrap types are the responsibility of the designer, Alternative support to galvanneal netting should be used in severe coastal environments including when aluminium is used.

## GENERAL NOTES:

- (1) REFER TO E2/A5.1 OR WANS WIS FOR GENERAL WINDOW OPENING FOR WRAPPING
- (2) WINDOW PROFILE TO BE SELECTED TO ACHIEVE COVER SHOWN IN DETAILS.
- (3) ARCHITRAVES ARE SHOWN FOR CONSISTENCY ONLY, DETAIL MAY BE USED WITH REBATED LINER.
- (4) WHERE SUPPORT BRACKETS ARE REQUIRED BY THE WINDOW MANUFACTURER TO CARRY THE FRAME AND GLAZING LOADS THEY MUST BE SUPPLIED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE WINDOW MANUFACTURERS RECOMMENDATIONS.
- (5) LASE WITH WINDOW MANUFACTURER PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
