A professional finish starts with quality preparation. This is essential to achieve the longest possible lifespan from your timber coating. Intergrain's UltraPrep range contains advanced formulas to restore and rejuvenate exterior and interior timber, providing the strong foundation needed to achieve a high performance finish.

REMOVER

Intergrain UltraPrep™ Tannin & Oil Remover

- Removes old or weathered timber finishes in poor condition.
- Helps draw out tannins and oils quickly and removes them from the timber surface.

Use on: All exterior timber. NOT suitable for interior timber.

Note: Tannin & Oil Remover is not a paint and varnish stripper. To remove paint and other timber coatings that are in sound condition, use Liquid 8° Timber Stripper.



CLEANER

Intergrain UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner

- Contains oxalic and citric acid for high strength cleaning power.
- · Always use before coating.

Use on: All exterior timber. NOT suitable for interior timber.



MOULD REMOVER

Intergrain UltraPrep™ Mould Killer

- Use on mould affected timber.
- Ideal in humid, tropical and mould susceptible areas.

Use on: All exterior timber.



TIMBER STRIPPER

Liquid 8[®] TimberStripper

- High performance timber and paint stripper.
- NMP free formula for safer interior usage.
- Deep penetrating to remove multiple coats in a single application.

Use on: All exterior and interior timber, metal, brick and masonry surfaces.





How To Prepare Your Timber

Identify the condition of your timber below and follow the steps to ready your timber for coating.



- 1. Treat with Intergrain UltraPrep™ Mould Killer.
- 2. Prepare the timber with Intergrain UltraPrep™ products as determined by the condition of your timber.



New timber

- 1. Use UltraPrep™ Tannin & Oil Remover to draw out the surface tannins.
- 2. Clean and neutralise the UltraPrep™ Tannin & Oil Remover with UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner.



Grey weathered timber with no previous coating

1. Use UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner to clean and remove degraded timber fibres.

Note: Severely weathered or degraded timber should be sanded back to a fresh surface before using $UltraPrep^{\mathbb{T}}$ Timber Cleaner.



Existing coating: worn and in poor condition

- 1. Use UltraPrep™ Tannin & Oil Remover to loosen and remove the remaining coating. Sand any small remaining spots of coating if required.
- 2. Clean and neutralise the UltraPrep™ Tannin & Oil Remover with UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner.
- 3. Before coating, complete waterbead test below.



Existing coating: in sound condition

Coating in the same product:

1. Clean and ready the timber for coating with UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner.

Coating in a different product:

- 1. Sand back or use a coatings stripper to remove the existing coating.
- 2. Clean and ready the timber for coating with UltraPrep™ Timber Cleaner.
- 3. Before coating, complete waterbead test to the right.



Removing an existing coating? Do this quick check:

After removing an old coating, conduct a waterbead test to confirm the timber is ready to accept a new coating.

If the water soaks in, the timber is porous and will accept a new coating. If the water beads, the timber is still repelling water and further removal of the old coating is required.

Exterior Timber Oils

Intergrain UltraDeck® Timber Oil

A long lasting, high performance water-based coating designed to enhance the natural colour of exterior timber, while providing superior protection against harsh weather conditions and the abrasive effects of foot traffic. Lasts 3x Longer than traditional oil-based decking oils.

Recoat: 3hrs Coverage: 10-14m²/L
Clean up: Water Pack Sizes: 250ml, 1L, 4L, 10L

Use on: All exterior timber.



Intergrain UltraDeck® Slip Resistant

A water-based coating that enhances the natural colour of exterior timber and provides superior protection in a subtly textured, slip resistant matt finish. Lasts 3x Longer than traditional oil-based decking oils.

Recoat: 3hrs Coverage: 10-14m²/L Clean up: Water Pack Sizes: 4L

Use on: Stairs, walkways, ramps and around pools.

Note: All colours represented are to be used as a guide only. Oils are lightly pigmented and transparent in nature, meaning the final colour will be impacted by the species and unique characteristics of the timber it is applied to. To see what your unique timber and colour combination will look like, pick up a 250ml sample pot to trial before applying to the entire area. Multiple coats will increase colour intensity and reduce the visibility of timber grain.

A penetrating, oil based timber finish designed to give a rich, natural oiled finish to highlight the natural characteristics of timber.

Exterior Timber Stains

Intergrain UltraDeck® Timber Stain

A long lasting water-based stain designed to transform the colour of exterior timber and provide enduring protection against foot traffic and harsh weather conditions.

Recoat: 2hrs
Clean up: Water
Use on: All exterior timber.

Coverage: Approximately 6-12m²/L depending on the porosity of the timber.

Pack Sizes: 250ml, 1L, 4L, 10L

Designed to help provide the ultimate finish on all exterior timber projects. The ultra soft bristles allow for quick, consistent coverage and are compatible with solvent and water-based coatings. Intergrain DeckBrush Applicator Head is a high

performance, re-usable applicator and is ideal for staining or oiling decks which can be screwed on to any regular painters pole.

PAINT

A commercial strength, clear, water-based finish for timber flooring with superior wear resistance that preserves natural colour.

Recoat: 4hrs Coverage: 10-12m²/L
Clean up: Water Pack Sizes: 1L, 4L, 10L
Use on: Timber floors, stairs, parquetry and cork.

Sheens: Gloss & Satin
