Hale 3mm Wall Panelling is a 3mm thick Compact Laminate incorporating the same properties and benefits of 13mm Compact laminate.

Being 3mm, the panels are light weight and installed easily using a silicone modified adhesive directly onto a smooth, clean, dry substrate such as Gib board or Ply— no reduction to internal spaces through the use of battens.

Available in two sizes; 2440 x1220 and 3660 x 1525mm (Indent) with associated jointers, capping and corners in silver anodised aluminium.

Significantly the Hale Compact Laminates offer a Fire Certification that achieves 1-s to the New Zealand Building code Clause 3.

This allows the panels to be used in a fire egress situation.

Offering an Anti-Microbial, Anti-Fungal, Anti-Graffiti, High Impact and water resistance, the 3mm is suitable for the following areas;
