We only buy from the best. Jacobsen is committed to creating a sustainable sourcing culture, an important part of our commitment to the social and environmental wellness.

We work with suppliers who put their people and the environment first, and our Re.Spect icon signifies the expectation we have of them in the areas of ethical business, labour and human rights, health and safety, environmental sustainability and corporate responsibility.



Environmentally Friendly

We're looking after the planet for us and our children after us. We not only look at the manufacturing process to ensure all our products are produced in an environmentally friendly way, but also we look at the life cycle of the finished product.

It's important to us that our products perform in a way that protects you and your family from dangerous emissions, from harbouring insects and cultivating mould and mildew.



Industry Tested

All our carpets are tested for performance in the country they originate from. This means that there are a number of different standards and tests that are carried out on our carpets. The air we breathe is so important that's why it's important that the products we put in our homes are healthy. We measure PVC (PolyVinyl Chloride) content and VOC (Volatile Organic Compounds) emissions to ensure you are breathing the purest air possible.

Some of the most common tests are:

Environmental Certification Scheme

Provides a guide to the environmental performance of carpet. Carpet manufacturers must comply with the Code of Practice for Environmental Management which provides performance standards for raw materials, carpet manufacturing, in-service use and final disposal. Highest Level: 4

ACCS or Australian Carpet Classification Scheme

Classifies carpets according to their durability and appearance retention.

Highest Residential Use: six stars

Highest Commercial Use: four stars

The Dying Process

HOW IS CARPET COLOURED?

There are two ways to produce coloured nylon fibre. The first is a traditional dying process called piece-dyed nylon and the second is mixing the colour into the production process, this is called solution-dyed nylon. The result of these two processes are most simply explained by looking at a radish and a carrot.



Piece-dyed Nylon

Radish: Traditional-dyed fibre where the fibre is made, and then passed through dye. The colour is on the exterior of the fibre but does not go through to the core of the fibre.

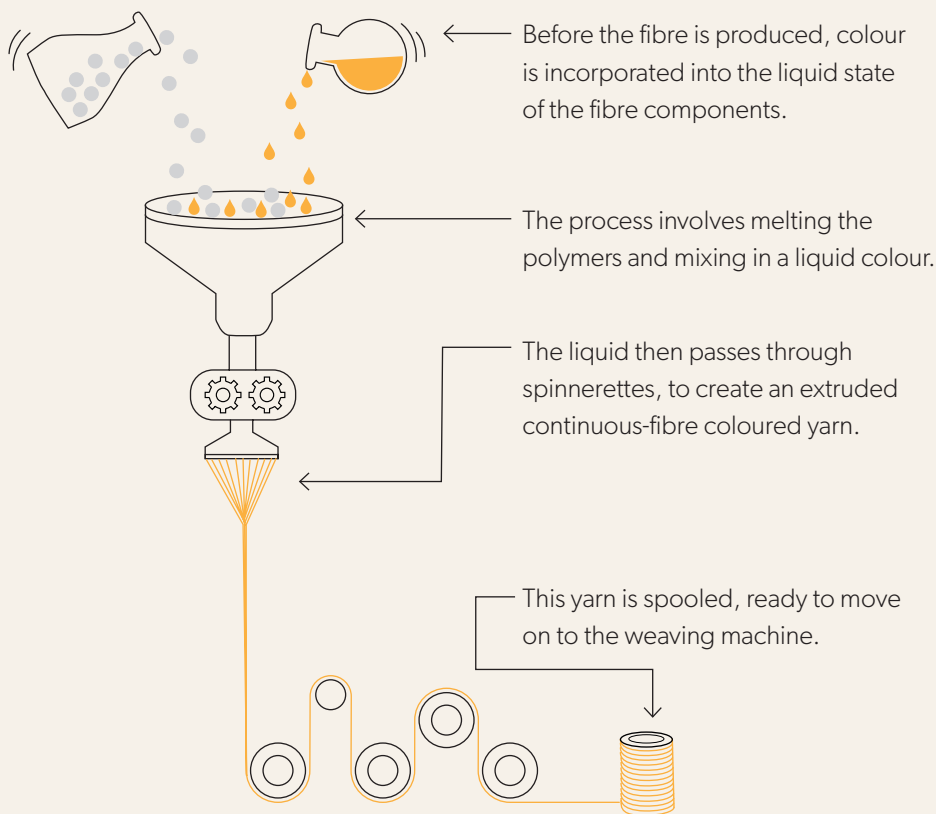


Solution-dyed Nylon

Carrot: Solution-dyed fibre has the colour mixed into the fibre itself, meaning that the colour is present all the way to the core of the fibre, giving it superior fade-resistant quality.

HOW IS SOLUTION-DYED NYLON MADE?

Raw material (polymers) and liquid colour (dyes), are fed into the top of the machine and melted. This melt is then forced through tiny holes called spinnerettes where the melt is drawn out, leaving the newly created coloured yarn.

Nylon carpets are resilient carpet and known for its elastic nature which means that it will bounce back easily making it well-suited for high foot traffic. Its elasticity, strength, and durability enable it to withstand bending, crushing, and stretching without losing its original shape or texture.

Dust and dirt remain on the surface of the fibres of solution-dyed nylon carpets making it easy to vacuum away most of the common sources of indoor allergens, making nylon flooring a practical option for those looking to improve their indoor air quality.

Solution-dyed nylon carpets are designed to resist stains, thanks to the fibre used in their production. This process ensures that the carpet's colour is locked in at the manufacturing stage, preventing spills from penetrating the fibres and causing stains.



Acoustic Quality

ACOUSTIC QUALITY

Carpets have excellent sound absorption properties, making carpet the perfect sound insulation material to reduce sound reverberation in a room and the ideal product to add noise reduction in builds where noise transfer is important, such as in apartments or multi-storey buildings.



UV Fade Resistant

FADE RESISTANT

Nylon carpets are resistant to fading, even when exposed to harsh sunlight in the New Zealand environment. Solution-dyed nylon has superior fade resistance due to the colour being mixed throughout the fibre making it the perfect choice for a north-facing room.



Thermal Quality

THERMAL QUALITY

Carpet acts naturally as an insulating material. The carpet fibres themselves have low heat conduction values and the surface of the carpet traps air in the pile fibres, and further increases the thermal insulation. The amount of insulation will greatly depend on the density of the carpet and the thickness of the underlay.



Insect & Mould Resistant

INSECT AND MILDEW RESISTANT

Because nylon does not absorb moisture, it is naturally resistant to mould and mildew growth. The synthetic fibres also mean this type of carpet is resistant to insects such as moths and carpet beetle that are commonly found in natural-fibre carpets, making it the healthier choice for your family.

Solution-dyed Nylon is made of Bulk Continuous Filament (BCF) of high-strength nylon fibre that have been coloured to the core of the filament meaning there are no breakages of weak points that are prone to pilling.

FEEL

This is a gauge of how 'plush' the carpet feels when you run your hand over it.



TRACKING

Tracking is measured by how visible footprints are left behind after someone has walked on the carpet.



PILE WEIGHT

The weight of the carpet can have a big influence on how 'dense' the carpet can feel and is measured in ounces (oz).



PERFORMANCE

This is measured by the ACCS or the carpet manufacturer as an industry standard for residential carpet performance.



PILE HEIGHT

The pile height gives you the feeling of comfort, the higher the pile, the more you will 'sink' into the carpet.



SUSTAINABILITY

While all our products are sustainably sourced and manufactured, some are in a league of their own.



GAUGE

The gauge is the measure of how close the pile is packed together, this gives the carpet a feeling of density.



CARPET WIDTH

The width of the carpet is important and should be considered to minimise either wastage and joins in your space.

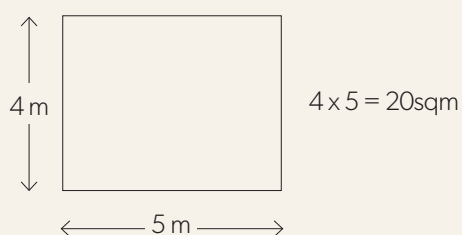

HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR SPACE

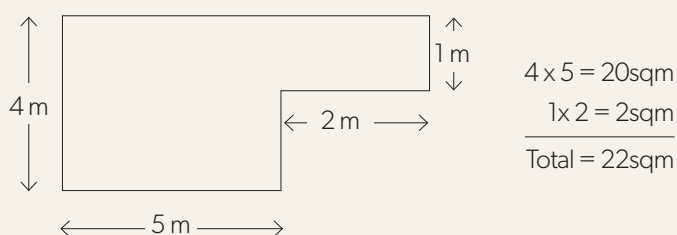
To calculate the square meter (sqm) measurement of your space, you will need to measure the length and width of the area in meters using a tape measure or measuring tool.

Once you have these measurements, simply multiply the length by the width to get the total square meters. For example, if your space is 4 meters long and 5 meters wide, you would multiply 4 x 5 to get 20 square meters ($4 \times 5 = 20\text{sqm}$).



If your space is an irregular shape or has multiple sections, you can divide it into smaller, more manageable sections and calculate the square meter measurement of each section separately, then add them together for a total.

It's important that your space is accurately measured by an installer to ensure that your carpet is ordered and laid in the most efficient way possible.



Caring For Your Carpet

CLEAN UP SPILLS AS SOON AS THEY HAPPEN

Fast action to any spillages will limit the penetration of the spill into the carpet fibres and pile. In the case of spills, remove the excess spillage by first scraping away any solids and blotting any liquids with a white cloth or paper towel. Do not scrub, always blot; never rub or scrub abrasively as a fuzzy area may result.

Always begin at the outer edge and work towards the middle of the affected area. Follow this treatment with cold water, apply the cold water with a sponge to rinse out as much of the spill as possible, then blot with a white cloth or paper towel. If the spill is serious or you are unsure of what it is, it's best to call in the experts straight away rather than tackling it yourself.

TREATMENT

Never scrub or rub at your carpet.

1. Cold water
2. Detergent solution or carpet shampoo solution
3. Laundry detergent (non-biological)
4. Solvent - use only on dry carpet
5. Chill with aerosol freezing agent or ice cubes in a plastic bag. Pick or scrape off gum or chocolate
6. Vinegar solution (1/3 cup white vinegar with 2/3 cup water)
7. Warm water
8. Clear nail polish remover (preferably acetone) no lanolin
9. Alcohol, methylated spirits or mineral turpentine
10. Rust remover
11. Vacuum
12. Mineral turpentine
13. Laundry detergent (non-biological) - 1 tsp in 250mls warm water
14. Clear household disinfectant

*Note: We **DO NOT** recommend the use of any bleach based cleaning products, such as Softly Wool detergent or similar.*

REGULAR VACUUMING

The most important step in caring for your carpet is regular vacuuming. Vacuum thoroughly and frequently, particularly in high-traffic areas. A good quality vacuum cleaner is vital to prolonging the life of your carpet. A light vacuum is recommended at least twice a week and a thorough vacuum weekly.

Carpet Performance

To ensure that you have a good understanding of your carpet and what to expect from it over time, it is important to consider some key characteristics. Below we have provided a summary of some of the main features that you should be aware of, although we recommend consulting the manufacturer's warranties for further details.

COLOUR VARIATION

It is normal for installed carpet to show minor colour variation from selling samples. There can be a minor variation between dye lots. Colour appearance can vary depending on the type of light under which a sample is viewed and the light sources where the carpet is installed. Viewing of the sample at your residence and under different light conditions prior to making your final decision is recommended.

TRACKING & MATTING

All carpets will change in appearance over time, primarily due to foot traffic. Tracking and matting are wear-induced characteristics that are more likely to occur on stairs, in front of chairs and in other high-traffic areas. Regular vacuuming and immediate cleaning of spillages are the greatest aid in preventing tracking and matting. Placing rugs in these areas will assist in its prevention.

HIGH USE AREAS & HALLWAYS

All carpets will change in appearance over time, especially in high-traffic areas. Matting and pile flattening can occur, resulting in the entanglement of fibres from tuft to tuft. This can be minimised with periodic professional cleaning and regular vacuuming.

WRINKLING & RUCKING

Wrinkling may occur after installation due to excessive humidity or not using the recommended installation procedures. This is not considered a carpet fault and can usually be corrected by a competent installer.

FADING & COLOUR CHANGE

Carpets will gradually lose colour over time when exposed to direct sunlight, and pile flattening through use can also give the appearance of fading. It is recommended to protect carpets from prolonged periods of direct sunlight and other environmental factors that can cause colour change.

SHEDDING

All carpets will shed a small amount of fibre when they are first installed. It is caused by some residual fibres left over from the manufacturing process. However, nylon will stop this shedding process after a short time unlike natural fibres that will continue to shed for the duration of their lifetime.

PATTERN MATCHING & SKEWING

Repeating patterns may not precisely match along the length or width of the carpet. Installation of patterned or textured carpet requires more time and effort. A competent carpet layer should be able to obtain a close pattern match in most circumstances, however some irregularities may still be visible. All carpets are subject to some degree of bowing and/or skewing. Bowing of up to 40mm over any single width of carpet is generally acceptable.

MISSING OR DAMAGED TUFTS

Pets can damage your carpet by scratching at the pile. Moving furniture can also damage your carpet. This damage can be repaired by a skilled installer or professional repairer. It is advisable to retain a small section of new carpet for this purpose.

Warranty Information

All Jacobsen carpets are covered by the NZ Consumer Guarantees Act 1993. Jacobsen endorse and recognise all rights of the consumer under the Consumer Guarantees Act. Therefore the carpet must be fit for purpose and free of manufacturing defects.

JACOBSEN CARPET WARRANTY

Jacobsen carpets are designed and are suitable for Extra Heavy Duty use in private residential homes. General wear and tear should be expected and is excluded from this warranty.

No carpet is completely stain proof, but the Jacobsen range has been specifically selected to offer superior stain resistance. This will increase your ability to clean up stains, not prevent stains.

This warranty expressly excludes and does not extend warranty coverage to any of the substances or causes of damage identified below:

- Failure to follow the care and stain removal procedures contained in this guide.
- All non-food and non-beverage substances.
- Food and beverages which contain dyes (e.g. curry, soy sauce and mustard).
- Extremely hot liquids.
- Substances which destroy or change the colour of the carpet (e.g. food colouring, bleaches, drain cleaners, plant food, very strong dyes, acids, faeces, urine, vomit and pet stains).
- Soiling in very heavy traffic areas such as stairs and staining which becomes permanent due to the failure to carry out the care and stain removal procedures contained in this guide.

To qualify, the carpet must have been first grade, installed professionally, on new underlay and the claim must be made by the original purchaser.

You must have attempted to clean the stain using the recommended guidelines. If the affected area remains unsatisfactory after using these cleaning procedures, then have the affected area professionally cleaned. If the affected area is still unsatisfactory after professional cleaning then you must within 30 days make a claim to the retailer you purchased the carpet from.

For the expected life of your Jacobsen carpet will not generate static greater than 3.5 kilovolts.

WARRANTY REPLACEMENT VALUE

If your carpet has been determined as unable to be repaired, we will offer replacement of a new carpet of the same or comparable type available through Jacobsen.

Like any asset, the value of your carpet also depreciates over time and with wear. Our warranty allows for the following depreciation table to determine the value of replacement materials:
